# LOST AND STRAY DOGS

## In Bushy Park

You might, or you might not be aware, that the Metropolitan Police no longer take responsibility for STRAY dogs. This task is now officially undertaken by the relevant local authority. In our case **Richmond upon Thames Council**.

Richmond Council keep a register of found and missing dogs in the Borough  
In addition they will arrange for any stray dogs that are tethered to be collected and taken to Battersea Cats and Dogs Home

**We are still *very* interested in any dog loose inside the Park.**

We strongly recommend that you contact us with any information regarding strays that are loose in the Park as they represent a very real danger to the deer and to themselves.
